

## CHANGES TO BUSING NEXT YEAR

Student Transportation Services of Thunder Bay (STSTB) administers transportation for students between home and school under a joint transportation agreement between the Lakehead District School board, Thunder Bay Catholic School Board, Conseil scolaire de district catholique des Aurores boréales, and Conseil scolaire du Grand Nord. As announced in February 2024, eligibility distances for most grades at all the school boards we service are changing effective for the 2024-2025 school year as a result of a new Ministry of Education funding formula.

As of September 1, 2024, the student transportation eligibility distances between home and school will be as follows:

<u>Transportation Eligibility Distances</u>

JK & SK: minimum 800 metres
Grades 1 - 8: minimum 1600 metres
Grades 9-12: minimum 3200 metres

Students eligible for transportation in urban or developed rural areas may also be required to walk to and from centralized school bus stops within the following distances based on their grade with elementary stop locations often based on the address of eligible younger students whenever possible:

Walk to Stop Distances

JK & SK: maximum 400 metres
Grades 1 - 8: maximum 800 metres
Grades 9-12: maximum 1600 metres

Exceptions to distance policies will be in effect for students with special

transportation needs, rural students who must walk along highways and ditches and urban students who must cross highways or do not have access to controlled crossings along multi-lane arterial roads.

All students, including ineligible siblings of younger eligible riders, who are not eligible for transportation next year will be removed from busing for September. Requests for Courtesy Transportation will open at the end of September.

Parents and students can confirm eligibility for transportation next year by selecting the eligibility tile at www.ststb.ca (note: the School Year selection at the bottom of the 'Can I Ride a Bus?' inquiry page must be set to 2024-2025)

Other changes for next year include bus company route assignments and route names.

First Student Canada and Iron Range Bus Lines remain as our service providers, however due to the results of a recent contract bidding process, the areas and schools that these companies service may change next year.

As most bus routes are being reconfigured to conform to the new realities of transportation funding, the current 'North' and 'South' designations will change to FS or IR to denote which operator is servicing the route followed by a three digit route code. This is being done to limit confusing our new routing with old routes names.

## YOUR BUSING INFO IS ONLINE

2024-2025 BUSING INFORMATION WILL BE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE PARENT PORTAL STARTING THE WEEK OF JUNE 24, 2024

The safe and confidential STSTB Parent Portal is an efficient tool to obtain your student's transportation information and can be accessed easily and conveniently at www.ststb.ca. First time users of the Parent Portal are required to set up an account and, once created, students can be added to the account to view their busing info.

To add a student, you will be asked for their Ontario Education Number (OEN), and date of birth, as well as school attending and grade for the school year indicated in the School Year field at the bottom of the screen). As an OEN may not have been assigned yet for next year's JK students, incoming JK student's busing info can still be accessed using their Student ID in the OEN field.
