



The 'WAYFINDERS' program teaches older Elementary students to be capable and confident walkers. An active, safe and visible commute brings peace of mind to parents who want their children to be equipped and supported on the walk to and from school.



'WAYFINDERS' receive thorough Street Safety Training. This equips them with an understanding of safety around traffic, crossing a street, anti-bullying awareness and basic first aid training. These students are our walking experts!

'WAYFINDERS' do not pick up students, are not responsible for babysitting smaller children, and are not expected to save lives. They are expected to set a responsible example, to know safe walking procedures, and to be welcoming of all other students who elect to walk with them.

'Wayfinders' are asked to wear a C2 Safety Vest. Having a visual cue of vested students walking in the community and converging upon the school during commute time serves as a BRIGHT ALERT to motorists that there are young pedestrians nearby, improving safety for everyone.

Parents are still ultimately responsible for getting their own children to and from school, but Wayfinders are in place to demonstrate preferred routes to school, to add increased visibility, and to set a positive walking example for all students.
